Transportation to Ghana

Most major airlines fly into Accra's Kotoka International Airport (KIA): KLM, BA, Alitalia, Lufthansa, Ghana International, North American Airlines, Kenya Airways, Ethiopian Airways, etc. Please book early and aim to arrive on Sunday 2nd July. Please send us precise flight and arrival information.

Airport Shuttles

We will arrange airport pick-up by the School buses to Tema.

Visa Information

Most visitors need visas to enter Ghana so please check with your airline or tourist offices or nearest Ghana Embassy. The school is ready to assist with letters of invitation or names of referees.

Health and Safety

Ghana is a peaceful country with the friendliest population you are ever likely to meet (although it has its normal share of con men and chancers!). Malaria is endemic and all visitors should take anti-malaria medication a minimum of two weeks before, and during, and two weeks after returning. (Consult your own doctor). Please bear in mind that millions of Africans and thousands of expatriates are living here safely, healthily and happily, and so will you.

Medical Insurance

Although there are good medical services in Ghana, all participants are advised to take medical insurance from their countries of origin.
